# What Is a Customized Learning Course (CLC)?

It's a course that the student participates in by:

1. Choosing a topic of interest with help from an academic department head.
2. Helping find an instructor (if needed).
3. Studying independently and meeting with the instructor in person or online.

## Who Can Take a CLC?

Normally only students in their 3rd or 4th year of a program

**Instructors are experts (usually with a Master's degree or higher in the area of interest) who agree to guide a student through on-line or in-person meetings.**

**Students may help find an instructor by networking with assistance from the college.**

# Details

It's possible to design a CLC as any of the following types of courses: Bible & Theology, Professional Studies, or General Studies.

A student may take a single CLC or group them into concentrations of up to 4 courses. One can specialize in topics as varied as urban or rural ministry, addictions, play-therapy, business as mission. children at risk, or something entirely different.

Courses & concentrations must fit into student programs.

CLC's are taken within a regular semester. Application is due two months in advance of the semester of study.

A student with an idea for a CLC should consult with the appropriate department head in order to review the suitability of the course and to plan on how to obtain an instructor. If the college does not already know of a suitable instructor, the student will be given assistance in finding one who will fit his or her needs.

Instructors without Master's degrees may be selected if they have sufficient experience and are willing to work under an approved faculty member. All CLC instructors receive a small payment for their participation.
